The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$14,413.42, Cooperative checks totaling \$4,387.85, Student Fee checks totaling \$1,530.00, Activity checks totaling \$19,266.40 and Escrow checks totaling \$53,826.67.

The Principal reported NSCAS testing is complete. The elementary enrollment is 138. Summer school will be held May 28 through June 28 for those students who received invitations. The Elementary Library/Para position deadline is May 1<sup>st</sup>. Anita Sahagun was hired at the Kitchen. Upcoming events include early dismissal on April 18<sup>th</sup> for the Easter break. The grade 5 – 8 musical will be held on April 25. Kindergarten roundup will be on April 26 and grades 3 and 4 will be attending Life on the Farm. May 3<sup>rd</sup> is Spring Sprints and 6<sup>th</sup> Graders will have Move Up day on May 6<sup>th</sup>. Plan to attend the elementary Multicultural Night on May 9<sup>th</sup> from 6 to 7 p.m.

The Superintendent mentioned that classified staff agreements will be handed out soon. A 2.5% increase is being proposed. Job descriptions for a few positions have been updated. Interviews for the Elem. Librarian/para will be held after May 1<sup>st</sup>. Graduation will be held on May 11<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 p.m. Two staff days have been added to the school calendar. Bids for Phase 3 remodeling will be opened on April 25<sup>th</sup> so hopefully work can begin right after school is out in May. A playground fence will be installed at the elementary and some sidewalks will be replaced. The school will be purchasing a broom to attach to the bobcat. Coaching and extra duty positions have been assigned. Testing at the high school has been completed.

Committee reports: Americanism/Civics reported that LB 399 was signed into law.

The Board discussed Phase 3 remodeling. Updated drawings were forwarded to board members. English/Language curriculum will need to be updated. Cameras in the route buses were discussed. There are fines for going around a stopped bus and with updated technology these fines can be enforced. Installation will be done on site and will be able to be moved in the event of bus replacement. Wayne State College is adding classes that seniors may take for college credit on Fridays. This is similar to Fridays at Northeast.
