The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$19,263.64, Escrow checks totaling \$36,674.65, Cooperative checks totaling \$1,943.70, Student Fund checks totaling \$688.50 and Activity checks totaling \$6,119.93.

The Elementary Principal reported that Carter Hans and Molly Miller each placed 1st at the spelling bee in Center. February pre-school had 11 children in attendance. Upcoming events include the Music Showcase on March 3rd from 3 p.m. – 6 p.m. National Breakfast week will be March 4 – 8, Miles of Smiles on March 7th, there will be no school on March 8th due to spring break. Maps testing will be March 12-14, Title Math night on March 14th and there will not be kindergarten on March 15th due to Pre-school day.

Mr. Alexander continue to follow legislative updates. Teacher contracts will be issued soon. The board was given a copy of the master calendar for the 2019-2020 school year. The Superintendent is working closely with Prochaska and Assoc. on Phase 3. We are hoping to let bids the end of February or the first week of March. Mr. Alexander is watching the progress of two seniors that may not graduate if their work is not completed by the end of the year. Maps testing will be on March 12-15 and NSCAS testing in April. Prom will be on April 13th. The juniors will be taking an ACT test on April 2nd.

Committee reports included: Curriculum/Americanism, Building & Grounds, Budget, Transportation, Negotiations/Staff Relations, and Administration Review.

The Board discussed warranty repair work that was completed by DWB on Feb 18th. The master calendar was discussed, Elementary Principal contract renewal and teacher contracts will be handed out soon. Phase 3 remodeling bids will be ready to go out very soon. Asbestos removal of tile will start right away as school is dismissed. T& H Drywall will be working in the old gym very soon to finalize Fire Marshall requirements. Karen Haase of Perry, Guthrie, Hasse & Gessford will be at the school on March 5th to present an assembly to 7-12 students. She will also be working with faculty and staff.
