The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$15,534.94, Escrow checks totaling \$45,758.14, Cooperative checks totaling 3,474.90 and Activity checks totaling \$19,806.30.

The Elementary Principal reported that there was 99% attendance at the spring parent/teacher conferences. Current elementary enrollment is 136. Continue to save Box Tops for Education as we received \$546.90 the last time they were sent in. Maps testing has been completed. Title I math night and Preschool were cancelled due to inclement weather. Upcoming events include March 28th spring musical for grades 5 – 8. April 1 will be a lyceum, NSCAS testing will be April 9-11, April 10 ECOC meeting and April 11 will be the Title 1 meeting.

The Athletic Director mentioned that the volleyball head coach position has been filled by Kaydee Alexander. The school has implemented locker room supervision before and after sports and PE practices. There are a few adjustments to the basketball schedule for next school year. Junior High football will continue to coop with Wausa.

The Superintendent reported that Bloomfield will be hosting driver's education classes the end of May at a cost of \$250 per student. The pre-bid walk through will be held in the next week or two for Phase 3 remodeling. Sealed bid opening is scheduled for April 25th. Contract for certificated staff will be handed out. These are due back on April 15th. Classified work agreements will go out in the next couple of weeks.

Maps testing is finished at the High School. NESCAS testing will take place next month. We may look at going to larger screens as computers are replaced at the elementary and we will be using more mobile carts. Mrs. Hauger has requested the use of teacher sick bank. Seniors who have completed their studies will be approved for graduation.

There were no committees that met this past month.

The Board discussed Phase 3 remodeling, final drawings and the Notice to Bidders will be going out. Sealed bids will be opened at 2:00 p.m. on April 25th. Mrs. Howder, Elementary school librarian, has turned in her resignation effective at the end of the school year. We wish her well in her retirement. A job posting will be placed in the paper for her replacement. Those seniors who have finished their course requirements will be approved for graduation. Teacher sick bank discussion was held.
