Teachers

- Hold Parent-teacher conferences twice annually, as determined by the administration.
- Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress, including positive feedback.

- Assign meaningful homework to support classroom learning.

 - Parents receive a monthly newsletter of school information, activities and events.
 - Parents will be welcomed into classrooms. Arrangements to volunteer or observe can be made in advance by contacting the classroom teacher.
