## 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR LIST OF INCREDIBLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

#### **STUDENT SUCCESS**

- Students raised \$11,000 for a school wide read-a-thon:
- 215 students were recognized with monthly Math, Reading, and Holy Spirit awards;
- Students experienced social-emotional growth by having daily peer interactions;
- Students collected toiletries to benefit foster children in Butte County;
- Students collected \$3000 to benefit Sister Teresita's Orphanage in Vietnam;
- 17 8th graders graduated on May 26th, 2021 in a special ceremony.

#### **TERRIFIC TEACHING**

- Teachers, even with restrictions and unusual COVID protocols, worked tirelessly to provide high quality academic instruction for all learners;
- From September 28th, 2020 to June 3rd, 2021, positive growth was achieved in both STAR Math and STAR Reading tests among students;
- A total of 82,368,455 words were read by Notre Dame students;
- In-person instruction was offered for 215 TK-8th Grade students.

#### **PARENT PROWESS**

- The PTO presented a fantastic Spaghetti Drive By Dinner/Silent Auction which served over 750 meals and raised \$14.500:
- The PTO united to serve a Glamorous Gourmet Drive-By Cornish Game Hen Dinner and Online Auction, raising close to \$60,000 in auction and dinner proceeds, and \$25,000 in raffle ticket sales:
- 28 new families were welcomed to the Notre Dame School community.

#### **PARISHIONER PRIDE**

- 40 students received First Holy Communion on April 24th, 2021;
- 17 students received the sacrament of Confirmation on May 8, 2021;
- The interior of the church was beautifully renovated.

#### **DONOR DEDICATION**

- 3 new projectors were purchased for classroom use;
- The snack shack was renovated;
- 3 new macBook computers were purchased for 2 teachers and Mrs. B.
