


The Wheels on the Bus Go Round and Round, Sorta

Did you know that Butteville had the highest CAASPP test scores in math and second highest in English Language Arts in Siskiyou County last year?



Dang yo, that's awesome!!! CAASPP testing continues with grades 7th and 8th grade will take the test next week. It is extremely important to make sure your child gets a good night's sleep and eats a good breakfast during testing week. You may talk to Mr. Foreman if you want your child to opt out of testing. Parents/Guardians have the right to have their students opt out of State testing. To do so they must send the principal a written request via either email or a hand delivered letter prior to the beginning of their students testing. The school is required to have 96% of all students participate in

testing. Students who do not participate at the request of parents/guardians are counted against the participation requirement. Schools that fail to reach the 96% requirement are subject to sanctions from the State.


