

Class of 2019 End of the Year Timeline

All seniors will be in attendance Friday, May 10th for senior awards ceremony. Senior Finals will be given Wednesday, May 08th through Thursday, May 09^h. Students must show up to the classes that teachers require them to take finals in during this time. After a final has been given in one of the senior's classes they will no longer need to attend that class again. Seniors must be in class, studying for finals in the library or out of the building. No loitering.

Tuesday, May 07th at 2:00, seniors not taking finals turn in their computers at the library.

Thursday, May 09th at 2:00, seniors who had finals will turn in their computers at the library.

Thursday, May 09th at 3:00, lockers checked for seniors. Fees assessed if locker not cleaned out.

Friday, May 10th at 8:00 a.m. there is a senior meeting in the gym to go over ceremony schedules and other requirements. At 8:30 the senior award ceremony will commence in the gym. You and your parents/grandparents are invited to attend.

Monday, May 13th at 12:00 all HHS and Spoon River College grades are due for seniors. Graduates, top ten, Valedictorian and Salutatorian will be determined afterwards. I will call the parents of the Valedictorian(s), Salutatorian(s) and top ten to inform them that evening.

Wednesday, May 15th at 7:00 p.m. is Baccalaureate at the High School. Seniors must let Mrs. Boyce know if they will attend by Monday, May 13th at 3:00 p.m. Melinda will need to know who is giving the Invocation, the Benediction and who will be the speaker by Wednesday, May 09th.

Thursday, May 16th as early as 9:00 and NLT 11:00 a.m. Valedictorian(s) and Salutatorian(s) speeches are due. Come to the office and I will proof them. Bring digital version (5 to 10 minute speeches).

Friday, May 17th at 8:30 a.m. all fees and graduation requirements must be met in order to take part in the graduation ceremony.

Friday, May 17th at 8:30 a.m. will be senior graduation pictures in the gym. Seniors are to bring their gown, hat, tassel, and chords. Valedictorian and Salutatorian medals will be given out before pictures. Interstate will take a group photo and then the individual memory mate photo if you want one. Order forms are in the office. During your individual photo is when you can wear other tassels or cords if you have them.... Not during group photo.

After pictures, at approximately 9:30, we will have graduation rehearsal in the gym until we are confident. Attendance at graduation practice is mandatory to take part in the ceremony.

At Approximately 11:00 a.m. we will travel over to New Central for our Senior Class Clap out and return to the High school to be released.

Sunday, May 19th at 2:00 p.m. Graduation will begin in the gym. Each graduate will receive two tickets for seating on the floor. All graduates will be in the cafeteria by NLT 1:30 ready to lineup. Please check in with Tory Wickman one of the Junior Marshals. He will have the check off roster when you enter the cafeteria to keep track of accountability. Once entering the cafeteria, seniors will stay in the cafeteria.

If you know of anyone needing handicapped seating, then please contact the office prior to Friday, May 17th at 1:00 p.m. Please let us know if they will be in a wheel chair or not. If there are special circumstances, such as divorced parents, then if we have floor tickets left over after everyone has two tickets and all handicapped guests are taken care of, then we will try to accommodate those needs after rehearsal.

Seniors will receive their diploma cover during the graduation ceremony. Their actual diploma will be distributed in the fitness center after the ceremony.
