## 1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to state the school system's administrative goals.

## 2. STRUCTURE AND GOALS

- A. **Administrative Organization** The system's administrative organization will be designed so that all divisions and departments of the central office and all schools are part of a single system guided by Board policies which are implemented through the Superintendent.
- B. Operational Goals The major goals of administration in the system will be:
  - (1) To manage the system's various departments, units and programs effectively.
  - (2) To provide professional advice and counsel to the Board and to any advisory groups established by Board action.
  - (3) To prioritize instructional leadership in order to assure the delivery, monitoring, and evaluation of effective learning programs and activities.
    - (a) Providing leadership in keeping abreast of current educational developments.
    - (b) Arranging for staff development necessary to meet the needs of students.
    - (c) Coordinating collaborative efforts toward the improvement of learning programs, facilities, equipment and materials.
    - (d) Providing on-going access to the planning, decision-making, and evaluation process for the ideas of staff, students, parents and others.

## C. Superintendent's Management Goals

- (1) The superintendent is responsible for overseeing the direction and the focus of the system through implementing, monitoring and evaluating a goal directed process aligned with local, state, and federal mandates and goals.
- (2) The superintendent will establish two system goals annually for discussion with the Board.
