## 1. DESCRIPTION

A. The Somerset County Public School System shall be open for student attendance for at least 180 actual school days and a minimum of 1,080 school hours for elementary and intermediate school students and 1,170 school hours for high school students.*
B. The annual operational calendar for the ensuing school year will be adopted by the Board of Education.
C. The calendar will:
(1) Reflect the instructional needs of the students, including compliance with the state requirement for 180 school days for students.
(2) Incorporate time to meet the staff development needs of the system and its employees.
(3) Accommodate the terms of the negotiated agreements.
(4) The school system will begin the school year before Labor Day when the Monday of Labor Day is on September 5th, September $6^{\text {th }}$, September $7^{\text {th }}$ or September $8^{\text {th }}$. The school system will begin the school year after Labor Day when the Monday of Labor Day is on September $1^{\text {st }}$, September $2^{\text {nd }}$, September $3^{\text {rd }}$ or September $4^{\text {th }}$.
D. When necessary the Board of Education will make written application to the State Board of Education as provided for in the Annotated Code of Maryland, 7-103(b) to adjust the school year.
