### Student Information in Newspaper

- 1. The following student information is acceptable to include in a newspaper publication:

  Secondary Students: student's picture or work with first name and last initial, last name only or first name only.

  Middle School and Elementary Students: student's picture or work with grade level identified or first name only.
- 2. Use of generic school pictures in which individual students are not identified, such as school groups or pictures of the crowd at a school assembly.

## Integrated Pest Management Survey
