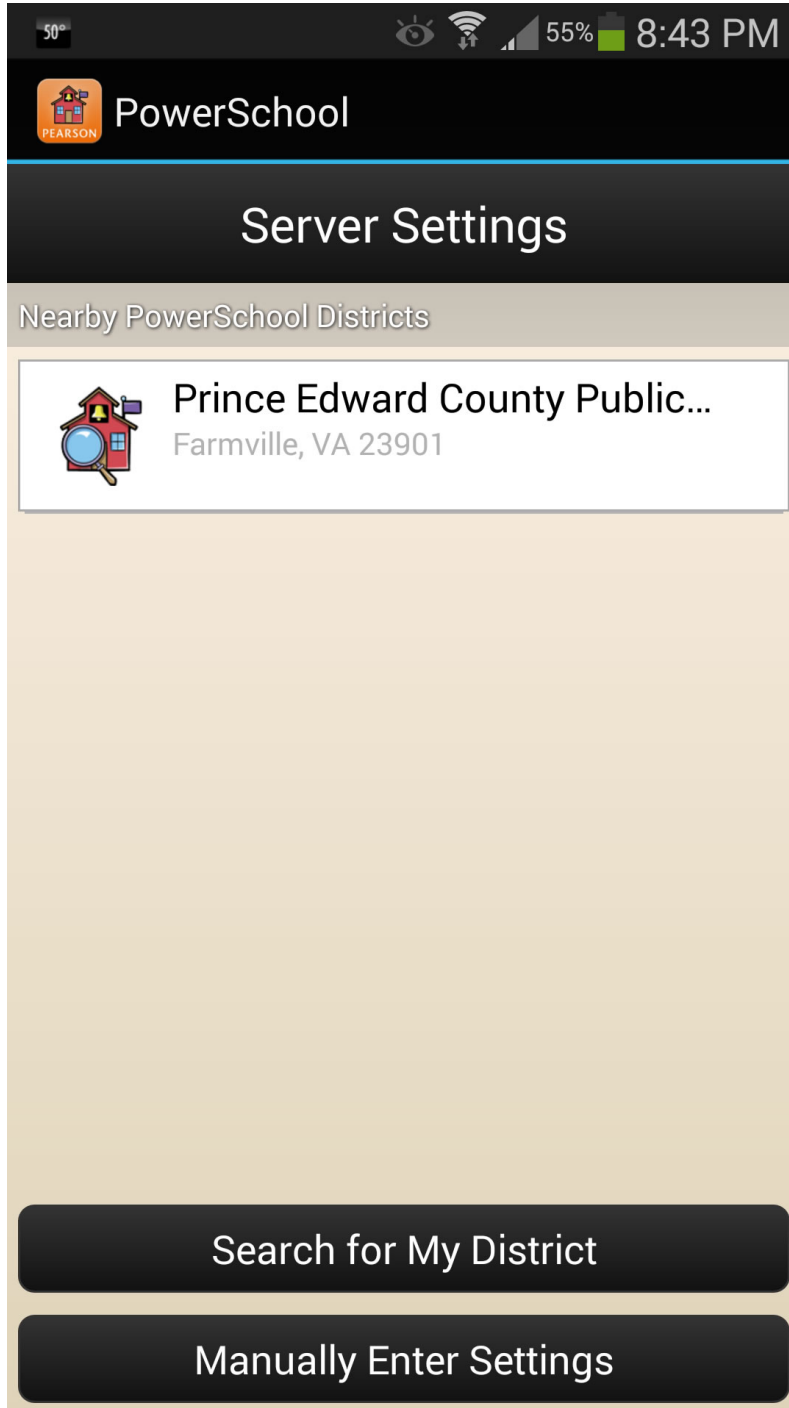


# How to Install and Setup Android PowerSchool Apps

1. Go to your Android App store and download and install the app you need: PowerSchool for Parents  
PowerSchool for Students
2. Once installed, open the app and select the **Manually Enter Settings** button at the bottom of the screen.




3. Enter the following on the Server Settings screen:

Server Address\*      cucps.powerschool.com

Port Number\*        443


SSL Enabled          check the box

Then tap on **Accept** to complete setup.
