In a school year, it is estimated that Virginia drivers illegally pass stopped school buses nearly 2 million times.

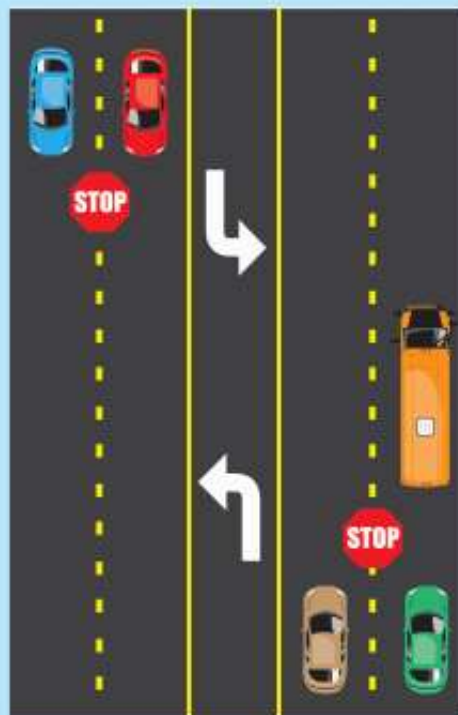
Virginia Motor Vehicle Laws require that motorists stop upon approaching any school bus which displays its flashing red lights and has its stop signs extended.



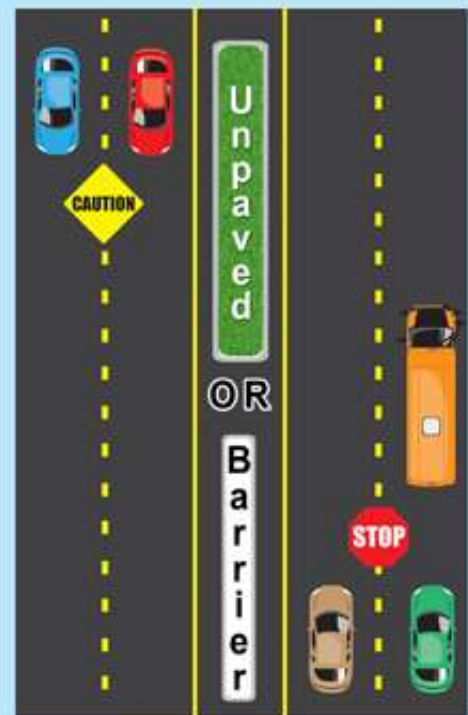
What Is The Law?



TWO-LANE:
Vehicles traveling
in both directions
MUST stop



MULTI-LANE Paved Across:
Vehicles traveling in both
directions **MUST stop**



DIVIDED HIGHWAY
Unpaved space (Min 5ft) OR any raised median/physical barrier.
Vehicles behind bus **MUST stop**.
Vehicles traveling in the opposite
direction proceed with caution.
