

# General Information & Concerns

- Door are unlocked for students at 7:25 a.m.

- Use the restroom, visit lockers, and get breakfast prior to reporting to homeroom.
- 1st Hour <u>begins</u> at 7:46 a.m. (Tardy Bell); Students should be at school no later than 7:40 a.m.
- Students are expected to be to class on time
  - o consequences may apply for tardiness.
- 3 "free" tardies to school <u>each semester</u>
  - Lunch detention issued for 4+

If your child is absent and you would like homework sent home, please let the office know first thing in the morning.

- Different teachers have different expectations
  & approaches to instruction.
- MMS is a part of a secondary school campus with shared staff.
- Most classes begin with bell ringer/jumpstart activities

- Students are required to dress daily for PE. The dress code includes green or black shorts and a Meridian shirt (or plain gray, white, or black). Failure to dress for PE will negatively impact the daily grade.



## Attendance

- Attendance is very important as students progress through the secondary grades.
- Students must be at school and ready for 1st hour by 7:40 a.m. each morning.
- If possible, please provide doctor's notes for absences/appointments.
  - Required after 10 excused absences
- Please call your student in daily (by 10:00 a.m.) if absent and <u>request</u> assignments to be picked up.
  - Students can also check Google Classroom.
- Please contact the <u>office</u> if your child will not be in attendance.
- Pre-planned absence Let the <u>office</u> know as soon as possible. A homework request sheet will be started from the office.
- Tardies: (to school) 3 excused per semester
  - 4th Tardy (and beyond) Lunch Detention

### Homework/Planbook.com

- An assignment notebook will be provided to students on the first day of school.
- Weekly & daily agendas are posted in each classroom.
- Lesson plans & assignments are easily accessible on Planbook.com.
- Information is also available on individual teacher webpages

- Grades are posted weekly on <u>TeacherEase</u> (replacing Tyler SIS).
  - Check grades often & communicate classroom concerns with the appropriate teacher.



# Home-to-School Communication

- Home—to—school communication is important for student success!
  - Please make sure we have a <u>valid</u> email address when you register. If this changes during the year, information should be updated in the office!
- The quickest way to communicate with teachers is through email. A list of email addresses can be found on the <u>MMS</u> website.
- The MMS Facebook page is updated regularly with information and news.
- MMS newsletters are emailed to parents/guardians and students bi-weekly & are also <u>posted online</u>.



### **Hawk Bucks**

- Student reward incentive for behavior and academic recognition.
  - \$5, \$10, \$20, & \$50 Bucks
- Students should store Hawk Bucks in a safe place.
- Students are asked to put first & last name on all Hawk Bucks before spending.
- Hawk Bucks can't be shared with other students.
- Hawk Bucks are only valid for one school year.
  - Designs change each year
- School supplies are available to purchase at the Hawk Bucks Store in the library.
- Casey's pizza drawings take place quarterly.
- Class auctions take place at the end of the school year with TONS of fun items.





## **Meal Accounts**

- All students have a meal account.
- Students use school ID to "pay" for breakfast & lunch.
- Please keep track of the account and do not get into a habit of carrying a negative balance.
- Students are not allowed to purchase an extra item or extra lunch if a positive balance is not available.
  - Please discuss what meal purchases are allow with your child.
- Cash/checks can be paid in the MMS office or placed in the drop box near the concession stand.
   Online payments can also be made on the district website as a one-time payment.

# **Medical Information**

6th grade students are <u>required</u> to have the following:

- Current Medical Physical
  - This physical will count as the \*athletic physical for 6th grade.
- Dental Exam due by May 15 or appropriate waiver on file
- Immunizations (up-to-date) due by October 15
- Eye Exam is only required for new (to the state of IL) students.

\*All Athletes — Must have a current physical each year — within the 12 month calendar <u>before</u> the season begins.



# Chromebooks

- All MMS & MHS students are assigned a district—owned Chromebook to take home.
- Students should ensure the Chromebook is charged each night.
- Acceptable Use Policy
  - No Expectation of Privacy
  - Contents and Activity can be monitored
  - Restrictions will be applied as needed
- Gaggle software is used to monitor student
  Chromebooks and accounts to ensure they are used safely and responsibly.
- Teachers use Chromebooks for a variety of educational experiences
  - O Google Docs, Google Classroom, Quizlet, etc.
- Loaner Chromebooks <u>are not</u> available for a student to use if a Chromebook is left at home.



Chromebook expectations & policy will be discussed with students on the first day of school. Students should not play games or visit websites that aren't educational on the Chromebook!

# Cell Phone Policy

- Middle School students are not allowed to have cell phones during the school day.
  - Exception: Lunch Period
- Cell phones should be off or on silent and stored in the assigned locker.
- An after school detention will be assigned if a student has a cell phone out and/or in use during a class period.
- Airpods/Earbuds are also not permitted during the school day without teacher permission.

If you need to get a message to your child during the school day, <u>call the office</u>. To help students stay focused, please refrain from texting/calling your child during the school day unless it's lunch time!





## **Bus Riders**

- Behavior expectations on the school bus are the same as at school.
- Please discuss positive bus conduct with your student.
- Expectations and consequences are provided in the <u>Handbook policy</u>.


# **IESA Extracurricular Activities**

# Eligibility & Participation

- We follow mandated IESA requirements.
- Student athletes must be passing all classes (including electives) to be eligible each week.
- Eligibility is reported by 2:00 p.m. Friday afternoon
  - Eligibility runs Monday Sunday
- If a student is listed as ineligible 3 times during one season (not consecutive), he or she is removed from the team.
