She also stated that many times there are early dismissals due to there be a lack of bus drivers to get certain students to activities and that it is the same student that have to leave early and this is causing a lack of learning and instructional time. Also, most of the students being dismissed are of lower socioeconomic status and are those that will suffer most by continual early dismissals.

The meeting adjourned for executive session at 8:18 p.m. for the purpose of discussing matters pertaining to the employment, appointment, of specific employees or officers, purchase or sale of property, pending legal matters, student discipline and negotiations on a motion by Member Herbert and seconded by Member Roush.
