**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE UPDATED 2022-2027
ALL-HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN FOR CUYAHOGA
COUNTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Lyndhurst, Cuyahoga County, Ohio is most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lyndhurst acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the City of Lyndhurst, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lyndhurst, Ohio, upon recommendation by the Fire Chief of the City after his review of said Plan, desires to formally adopt said Plan. Now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST,
CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. The City of Lyndhurst, Ohio does hereby adopt the updated 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan for Cuyahoga County.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Lyndhurst for the reason that it is necessary to adopt same as soon as possible. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
