Confirm decision of the Board of Zoning Appeals:

Case No. 2016-12

Recommendation made to Council to confirm the decision of the Board in Case No. 2016-12 to **grant** the requested variances Perrino construction from the provisions of Chapter 1161.11 (o) (2) of the Planning and Zoning Code to construct a proposed deck which will encroach 12 feet 7 inches into the required 40 foot setback, along with a concrete slab also encroaching into the required setback, and a proposed window well to serve as a below grade egress which will encroach 1.68 feet into the 5 foot minimum side yard setback requirement.
