ORDINANCE NO. 2016-45 INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 WITH CATTS CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE 2016 CONCRETE PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has previously entered into a Contract with CATTS Construction, Inc. for the 2016 Concrete Program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into a Change Order as set forth herein due to needed additions to the Program or unforeseen circumstances associated with the Program. Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a Change Order Contract with CATTS Construction, Inc. for the additional amount of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00), in addition to the Contract heretofore authorized by the Board of Control of this Council, to perform additional concrete repairs not included in the original concrete specifications but within the appropriated road budget, not included in the contract specifications, all as more fully set forth in Change Order No. 1, dated May 23, 2016, which is fully incorporated herein. The City Engineer has approved the aforesaid Change Order.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay the amount provided for in Section 1 of this Ordinance upon passage hereof and execution of the Change Order authorized herein and completion of the work.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Lyndhurst and its residents for the reason that it is necessary to approve the aforesaid changes so as to not unnecessarily delay the completion of the aforesaid Project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
