The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw her warrant for payment of any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving the proper certifications and voucher thereof, approved by the Council of the City of Lyndhurst, Ohio or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or by ordinance or resolution of Council to make expenditures, provided that no warrant be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Section 9. REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES: Any and all ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith, and specifically Ordinance No. 2016-82 to the extent it is inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed; otherwise, any provisions of such Ordinance not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect. Section 10. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. Section 11. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediately make the appropriations herein in order that the City can properly function and meet its obligations currently. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
