A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVANCE TAXES FROM THE PROCEEDS OF TAX LEVIES PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 321.34

WHEREAS, Section 321.34 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that any money in the County Treasury to the account of the City of Lyndhurst and lawfully applicable to the purpose of the current fiscal year may be drawn upon by request. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County be and is hereby requested to pay to the City of Lyndhurst any money in the County Treasury to the account of the City of Lyndhurst and lawfully applicable to the purposes of the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2020.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance be and she is hereby authorized to furnish a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
