## A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING COMMENDATION AND SINCERE APPRECIATION TO DAVID M. STRASSHOFFER FOR LONG AND FAITHFUL SERVICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF LYNDBURST AS A MEMBER OF THE LYNDBURST POLICE DEPARTMENT

**WHEREAS**, David M. Strasshofer was born on September 12, 1955 and was a 1973 graduate of Mayfield High School; and

**WHEREAS**, following in the footsteps of his father, who was a 33 year veteran of the Mayfield Heights Police force, David Strasshofer decided to pursue a career in law enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, David Strasshofer earned a Bachelor's Degree in Law Enforcement from Youngstown State University in 1977; and

**WHEREAS**, David Strasshofer began his career as a Lyndhurst Police Officer on October 1, 1979 and graduated from Basic Police School at Case Western Reserve University in December, 1979; and

**WHEREAS**, David Strasshofer was promoted to the rank of Sergeant in on July 1, 1988 and to the rank of Lieutenant on September 1, 1994; and

**WHEREAS**, David Strasshofer served on the SPAN SWAT Team as an operator sniper, the Suburban Auto Theft Strike Force and on a joint Mayfield Heights/Lyndhurst Drug Enforcement Team; and

**WHEREAS**, David Strasshofer is a 1992 graduate of the School of Police Staff and Command at Northwestern University and a 2000 graduate of the prestigious FBI National Academy (203<sup>rd</sup> Session); and

**WHEREAS**, on May 24, 2009 David Strasshofer was appointed Commander of the Lyndhurst Police Department Traffic Bureau; and

**WHEREAS**, David Strasshofer is married to Charlene – a veteran Gates Mills Police Officer – and they are the parents of twin sons, John and David; and

**WHEREAS**, David Strasshofer has served the residents of Lyndhurst for 39 years and 7 months making him one of the longest tenured employees of the Department and of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, This Council, the Mayor and the entire Administration wish to acknowledge the dedication of David Strasshofer as an employee, and a leader in the Lyndhurst Police Department. Now, therefore
