RESOLUTION NO. 2019-10 INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND ADOPTING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT NEGOTIATED BETWEEN THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, OHIO, AND THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION (NON-DISPATCH FULL-TIME PERSONNEL), RATIFYING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF SAID AGREEMENT BY THE MAYOR, DIRECTING THE PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION RETROACTIVELY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Collective Bargaining Agreement negotiated between the City of Lyndhurst, Ohio and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Non-Dispatch Full-Time Personnel), which is effective with the period commencing January 1, 2018 and terminating December 31, 2020, is hereby ratified and adopted, a copy of said Collective Bargaining Agreement being attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

- <u>SECTION 2.</u> The execution of said Collective Bargaining Agreement by the Mayor on behalf of the City of Lyndhurst, Ohio is hereby ratified and approved.
- <u>SECTION 3.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby directed to provide payment of appropriate compensation retroactively in accordance with the terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
- SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 5. This Resolution shall hereby be declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Lyndhurst for the reason that the action taken herein is necessary to provide adequate compensation and other benefits for essential employees of the city. It shall therefore take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
