

- Sacraments are an integral part of the weekend. There will be an opportunity for confession and the weekend will conclude Sunday afternoon with a special Mass. Family and friends are welcome at the Mass.
- The weekend is FREE. Donations are graciously accepted and help keep this program self-sustained. There is no need to stay away for financial reason.
