ExcitED includes partnerships with the Bucks County Department of Workforce & Economic Development, the Wistar Institute, and the Pennsylvania Society for Biomedical Research (PSBR).

U.S. News & World Report's 2022 Best High Schools rankings are those whose students demonstrated outstanding outcomes above expectations in math, reading and science state assessments, earned qualifying scores in an array of college-level exams, and graduated in high proportions. In coordination with North Carolina-based RTI International, a global nonprofit social science research firm, U.S. News ranked approximately 17,840 public high schools out of the nearly 24,000 reviewed. William Tennent High School has again earned recognition as one of U.S. News and World Report's Best High Schools in the nation and the state.



# AP Capstone Diploma & Certificate Program

William Tennent High School is one of approximately 1,800 schools worldwide to implement the AP Capstone Diploma program - an innovative program that allows students to develop the skills that matter most for college success, such as research, collaboration, and communication. The program consists of students scoring a 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research and on four additional AP Exams of their choosing to earn the AP Capstone Diploma. This signifies outstanding academic achievement and attainment of college-level academic and research skills. Students who score a 3 or higher in both AP Seminar and AP Research (but not on four additional AP Exams) earn the AP Seminar and Research Certificate.

# Centennial Virtual Learning Academy (CVLA)

Recognizing there are multiple pathways to scholastic success, CSD is proud to offer approximately 60 students a 100% virtual placement for the 2022-2023 school year and 15 additional students a blended pathway (mixing virtual and in-person schedules). These students are able to continue to pace themselves to a CSD diploma while simultaneously taking advantage of a flexible schedule outside the limitations of a traditional school day. #### **College, Career & Technical Education Pathways**

Middle Bucks institute of Technology (MBIT) is supported by Centennial School District. MBIT operates as a school-of-choice program pathway designed for WTHS students seeking to enhance their educational program with a highly relevant career and technical experience connected directly to the real world of business and industry. Over 400 business and industry advisors annually review and update the school's educational program.
