Johnson-Brock Student Chromebook User Agreement – 2019-2020

All students in grades 7-12 will have the privilege of their own school-issued Chromebook. Students will be allowed to use the Chromebook during the school day with no obligations.

If a student wishes to be able to use their Chromebook after school or take it home, two things must take place:

- 1. A \$25 Damage Deposit must be made.
- 2. A Student Chromebook User Agreement must be signed.

NOTE~ The \$25 premium will be waived for all students in a family if parents attend the Digital Citizenship Presentation on the night of Open House.

Students who do not do the 2 above things will be expected to return their Chromebook to the charging cart within 5 minutes of dismissal.

Self-Insurance Policy:

When the \$25 Damage Deposit is paid, damage that occurs due to misuse or neglect will be accessed:

- 1st incident student/parent pays 33% of repair/replacement
- 2nd incident student/parent pays 66% of repair/replacement
- 3rd or more incident student/parent pays 100% of repair/replacement

Student/Parent Responsibilities/Liabilities:

- If Chromebook is stolen or damaged:
 - 1. File a police report
 - 2. Notify the school of the incident and all details pertaining to the damage or loss
 - 3. Cooperate with the school during the investigation

NOTE~ A \$50 charge will be incurred by parents/quardians of a stolen or damaged Chromebook.

- If Chromebook is lost:
 - 1. Notify the school within 24 hours
 - 2. Cooperate with the school effort to locate the device
 - 3. Notify instructors and make provisions for assignments during the investigation

NOTE~ A \$50 charge will be incurred by parents/guardians of a lost Chromebook.

- Not covered by the school:
 - 1. Dishonest or criminal acts by student or family member resulting in damage
 - 2. Intentional acts or serious neglect by you or family member
 - 3. Damage to Chromebook by third party with whom you trusted possession

NOTE~ Full replacement cost of Chromebook may be accessed to student/parent.

School Responsibilities:

- Normal warranty items (defects in workmanship)
- Normal wear and tear
- Cosmetic damage that does not affect the function of the Chromebook

The School can revoke the privileges of Chromebook use for a student:

- If the student or parent violates any provision of the Chromebook User Agreement or the Board of Education Computer Network Use By Student Policy
- If a decision is made that it is to the benefit of all students in the School to end the program
- If an agreement is terminated by the parent (Chromebook returned to School)
- If the parent withdraws the student from the School which issued the Chromebook
- If the student is suspended, expelled or is dropped due to non-attendance

All students utilizing technology at Johnson-Brock High School are expected to observe the following acceptable use requirements.

As a student, I will.....

- Bring my school-issued Chromebook to school every morning fully charged.
- Transport the Chromebook to and from school in a protective manner, such as inside a backpack.
- Store the Chromebook in a secure location at all times when not using it.
- Never load unassigned extensions, apps, videos, or other items onto the Chromebook.
- Never reconfigure (or synch) my Chromebook without school permission.
- Immediately report device malfunctions, damage, theft, or loss to my teacher and school Technology Specialist.
- Keep the Chromebook clean with no attached stickers or other items that might deface or damage he device's surface, screen, or other parts.
- Keep the Chromebook away from food and all liquids.
- Teach others in my home or classroom the rules of using my Chromebook.
- Use the internet responsibly and refrain from accessing inappropriate sites.
- Use the Chromebook for only school-related purposes.
- If Chromebook is lost and turned into the office:
 - o 1st Offense Warning
 - o 2nd Offense and Subsequent Offenses \$5 fee charged for return
