1. Page 10 and 23 of the RFP indicate the performance bond is to be 5% of the total contract value.	Page 10, items d and e, Bid Bond and Performance Bond should be ten percent (10%) of the total contract value.
2. Page 31 of the Prototype Agreement indicates the performance bond should be in the amount of \$40,000.	Page 31 of the Prototype Agreement item 8.15 performance bond shall be ten percent (10%) of total contract value.
3. Are the food service workers represented by a Collective Bargaining Unit?	No.
4. Please provide hourly wages for the labor schedule found on Exhibit L.	See addendum a
5. Please provide the number of employees who are participating in a benefit package, and the number of employees designated as single, single +1, and family participants.	No employees are participating in health benefits. 1 employee participates in dental. Single plan
6. Schedule P indicates the FSMC must provide vehicle and driver to transport food & mail, we did not see the driver listed on Exhibit L, nor in the operating statements provided. Please provide the type of vehicle required, along with number of hours the driver is needed and current wage and benefit package.	This is currently handled by EWG staff. We want to transition to FSMC responsibility. Estimated hours 2-3 hours per day and a vehicle to transport lunches hot and cold to satellite location.
7. Please provide a copy of the renewal documents for operating year 2018-2019	See addendum b
8. What are the current prices for paid meals (Breakfast & Lunch) for the Elementary, Junior High School and Senior High School?	See addendum a
9. Bond Requirement – The RFP states 5%, but the Agreement exhibit states \$40,000.00, which is correct?	See addendum answers 1 and 2 above
10. Catering – for year-end 2018, there was \$35,532.00 in catering revenue, but through March 2019, there has been only \$1,099.00 recorded. What does the district recommend for estimated catering revenues?	For year end 2018 the district was catering to the Greene School which contributed to the higher catering revenue. The district is no longer catering to the Greene School.
