- *World Book Student* – For upper elementary students and above: Includes content of *World Book Encyclopedia*; multimedia (animation, video, photos); biography center; dictionary and atlas.
- *Enciclopedia Estudiantil Hallazgos* – For grades K-4 and older students and adults who speak Spanish and/or are learning to speak Spanish: Offers content of *World Book Kids* in Spanish.
- *Timelines* – For upper elementary students and above: Hundreds of customizable, interactive timelines of important events throughout history.
