### **School Board Election**

The School Board Election for Orion Community Unit School District #223 will be held on Tuesday, April 4, 2023. Five seats on the seven-member Board of Education will be filled at the April 4<sup>th</sup> election. One seat will serve a two-year (unexpired) term, expiring in 2025. Four seats will serve four-year terms expiring in April 2027. School board elections are nonpartisan and board candidates do not indicate a political party affiliation.

Membership of the Board of Education is restricted to a maximum of three members from any congressional township. The five seats with terms expiring in April 2023 are from the townships of Colona (2), Rural (2) and Western (1). On the basis of the existing board membership, members may be elected in the following numbers from each congressional township:

Not more than 3 may be elected from Lynn Township.

Not more than 1 may be elected from Western Township.

Not more than 3 may be elected from Andover Township.

Not more than 3 may be elected from Osco Township.

Not more than 3 may be elected from Colona Township.

Not more than 3 may be elected from Edford Township.

Not more than 3 may be elected from Rural Township.

Not more than 3 may be elected from Coal Valley I Township.

Candidates running for the four-year terms (four seats open) are Julie Abbott (Rural Township), Sonia Berg (Colona Township), Kimberly A. Nightingale (Rural Township), Jamee Sovey (Osco Township), Jonathan Stockton (Western Township), and Hayley Voorhees (Western Township). The candidate running for the unexpired two-year term is Amy Blommer (Colona Township).














### **News from the Nurse's Office**

The Orion School District is offering sports physicals for the 2022-2023 school year.

The Cost: \$10.00 (cash) The Place: Orion Middle School The Time: 4:30 p.m. - 6:30 p.m.

**Tentative Date:** Wednesday, August 2, 2023 (excluding 6th graders & incoming freshmen)



If you have had your child's 6th or 9th grade physicals done early, you may have to have a sports physical done if they are going out for a sport at the end of the school year. Physicals are only good for 390 days.

NOTE: All sports physicals must be on the IHSA cards provided by the school. These will be available at both schools and **need** to be filled out with parent's signature along with the attached questionnaire PRIOR to the sports physical. Bring the required forms to the Middle School when getting the sports physical.

PARENTS: Please note the attached physician's form needs to be filled out entirely and signed before a physical will be given. The doctors will not complete a physical on your child if these forms are not filled out properly.

All physicals are good for 390 days from the date they are issued. This is an IHSA State Rule.

### Additional News from the Nurse's Office:

We've been busy in the Nurse's Office. We are seeing strep, flu, colds and congestion, etc. Please listen to your child's symptoms. Do not send your children to school if they vomited in the last 24 hours. Remember, per our student handbook, temperatures must be normal for 24 hours without medication before returning to school. If they cough or have a runny nose continuously, please keep them home or see a physician because it is impossible for some to cover their coughs.

CRH parents - Please remember to check the lunch menu each day. We have had several students not liking lunch and throwing it away and then ending up hungry.

Changes in humidity and temperature result in increased asthma attacks. Asthma is the most chronic illness in childhood.

Also, the weather is getting nicer so get your kids outside. Activity is exercise and so important for a healthy body. Get out the bikes, go for a walk, take them to the park, rollerskate, walk the dog, etc. Just get active - an active body is a healthy body.

Please encourage your grade school student not to wear flip flops or slide-on sandals on the playground. They are an accident waiting to happen.

### As a Reminder:

The students in the following grades for the school year 2023-2024 will need the appropriate forms turned into the office on the state of Illinois forms.

**Kindergarten:** Physical, immunizations, dental and vision

**2nd Grade:** Dental

6th Grade: Physical, immunizations and dental 9th Grade: Physical, immunizations and dental **12th Grade:** Updated meningitis vaccine

Physicals and immunizations are due on the first day of school or your child will be held out of school. We also recommend

making a copy of your forms for your records.





#### Policy for Promotion and Retention-

Retaining a child can be one of the most difficult decisions in education. The decision to retain a student should be a cooperative venture between parents/ guardians, teachers, and administrators. The ultimate determiner should be what is best for the student. This is ascertained only after parties cooperatively analyze all variables. If no consensus is reached at the retention conference, the final decision rests with the building principal.

In all cases where a child is in danger of being retained, it is essential that the lines of communication between the school and the parents/guardians must be kept open throughout the school year. Along those lines, if the classroom teacher feels that there is a potential for retention, he/she will follow the following procedures. If, at the end of the first semester, the teacher feels that retention is a possibility,

he/she will write a letter to the parents/guardians outlining his/her concerns. Included in this letter will be a clear statement of the problem. recommendations for improvement, and a request for a conference to discuss the matter further.

- At the end of the third grading period, if the child has not shown any significant improvement, the teacher will again notify the parents/guardians of his/her concerns.
- Should the problems continue, a retention conference will be scheduled no later than the first week in May. Present at the conference, will be the parents/guardians, classroom teacher, and the principal. A final decision on retention will be made at that time



### **Scheduled Destruction of Old Records -**

If you graduated in 2018 and were involved in the special education program and would like your special education files, please call Laurie Thornburg at C. R. Hanna, 526-3386, Ext. 1352. These records need to be picked up before June 19. These records are scheduled to be destroyed over the summer.

Special education files are housed at C. R. Hanna for five years beyond graduation. If graduates do not request their files, the files are destroyed. If you are unavailable to pick up your records, they may be released to your parent or guardian. A permission note with your signature is required for release.



#### 12th Grade Final Transcripts -

By May 19, senior students will be required to make their final transcript request. Students will need to provide the name and address of where the transcript is to be sent. Students will also be asked to provide their intended major or career path as well as any scholarships they may have received. This information is used to help future students in applying for scholarships. A parent's signature will be required for any student who is not yet 18. Final transcripts will be mailed before June 9.

The high school must mail transcripts directly to the school or employer in order for it to be considered an "official" transcript. Each student will receive a copy of their final transcript and report card by mail. All transcript requests must be in writing with the student's signature.
