

**Resolution of the Board to Set Tax Rate
(If Maintenance and Operations Tax Revenue Will Exceed Previous Year)**

On this date, we, the Board of Trustees of the Muleshoe Independent School District, hereby levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2022-2023 at a total tax rate of \$1.2305, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collector as follows:

\$1.0146 for the purpose of maintenance and operations, and

\$.2159 for the purpose of payment of principal and interest on debts.

Such taxes are to be assessed and collected by the tax officials designated by the District.
