## Discussion:

**IASB Code of Ethics #4:** I will take no private action that might compromise the board or administration and will respect the confidentiality of privileged information.

**Summer Projects:** The plans for summer window replacement are being formed, Lot C and the security path will be resealed this summer and all lots will have any necessary patchwork done. The bid packages for the auditorium seating and lighting have been opened and are being scheduled, Bid Package openings will be April 18th for the Fitness Center, Manufacturing Shop, Stadium Concessions/Locker Room, JH Restrooms and Elementary School Restrooms. Bid packages for the concession stand/restrooms for the baseball and softball fields are being put together now.

**Petty Cash:** During the FY18 audit, it suggested that we should consider implementing a practice for standardizing our petty cash within the district. There was no concern for misappropriations, but they felt a standardized process would ensure this good fiscal responsibility. Currently there are four petty cash boxes in the district. HS, JH, Elem, Unit office with variance of \$50 & \$130

Job Descriptions: With the transitioning of two positions (Director of Maintenance and District Registrar & Director of Grants), it was best to update the job descriptions. There are no significant changes to the descriptions and they will be in the consent agenda next month. Along the lines of Director of Grants, there has been a review of federal grants. Within the federal grants, there are opportunities to address the social and emotional needs of our students through a variety of strategies. One such possibility is to have a comfort dog on campus next year. It was proposed we consider adding a job description for a comfort dog aide. This person would be the liaison between the dog and our students.

**Organizational Health:** Mr. Vallas gave a brief update. The survey is to monitor school culture and climate. The information will be shared with the staff soon.
