## \*\*Junior High/High School Announcements\*\*

### Class Registration for 2023-24 School Year

Over the next couple of weeks students will begin class registration for the 2023-24 school year. Juniors registered on Tue April 18 and sophomores registered on Wed April 19. Here are the dates when freshmen and 8th graders will register next week:

- Mon April 24 (3rd period/auditorium) - Current 8th Graders in Guidance/Technology
- Tue April 25 (3rd period/library) - Current Freshmen in Freshman Seminar
- Tue April 25 (advisory/auditorium) - Current Freshmen NOT in Freshman Seminar
- Thur April 27 (3rd period; auditorium) - Current 8th Graders in Health/Spanish

Several important changes have been made to the Course Description Book, which has been approved by the school board, and which would be helpful for both guardians and students to read together. You can reference the changes in the linked [2023-24 COURSE DESCRIPTION BOOK](#) with the indicated page numbers.

### **New for the 2023-2024 School Year:**

- Grading Scale (p. 44-45) - There will no longer be A+ in the grading scale. A 93% and higher will earn a student an A in the course. On the standard scale, this will equate to a 4.00; on the weighted scale, this will equate to a 4.33.
- Required Core Coursework Sequencing (p. 4-7) - These graphics lay out exactly which courses are needed for graduation requirements, as well as course sequencing recommendations to prepare them for life after high school, whether that's college or career.
- Dual-Credit Readiness Recommendation (p. 8) - These recommendations should be reviewed together by both the student and their guardian to ensure the student is fully prepared for the rigors of dual-credit college coursework during high school.
- Course Summaries - The course descriptions have been completely revised! Explore the new and improved course description book to find information about the course's teacher, credits, grade level, length, semesters offered, prerequisites, and student-centered description. You can also use the CMD+F or Control+F to look up courses by specific identifiers. Looking for courses that get you ready for college? Try searching *#collegeprep*. Looking to get hands-on in the classroom? Try searching *#handson*. Looking for awesome classes that sometimes fly under the radar? Try searching *#hiddengem*. Use all these details to help narrow down your course selection process.
- New Courses for 2023-24 - There are many new courses coming to Logan-Magnolia High School next year! Look these up (try using the search feature and type *#new*) to read more about their expectations and any necessary prerequisite courses.
