- ✓ REQUEST LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION NOW – REQUEST FORMS AVAILABLE AT THE CCRC*
- ✓ OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS CAN BE REQUESTED IN ROOM A-2 OR ONLINE AT WWW.PARCHMENT.COM
- ✓ TO HAVE THE CCRC REVIEW AND/OR MAIL A SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION ON YOUR BEHALF, THE APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED TO US 5 DAYS BEFORE THE SCHOLARSHIP DUE DATE
- ✓ If submitting a paper application, we recommend to type and/or write neatly
- ✓ Keep in mind that some scholarships **will select multiple** winners - Visit the CCRC for more information about the scholarships
- ✓ Always write a Thank You card to people who write letters of recommendation on your behalf and to organizations that award you with a scholarship – Thank You cards are available at the CCRC
