





DEMOGRAPHICS

The Johnson-Brock School District has a K-6 Elementary School and 7-12 Jr.-Sr. High School with both schools located in Johnson NE. There were a total of 322 Students in the PreK-12 system during the 2014-2015 school year.

Johnson-Brock had **88** students from other school districts through the Option Enrollment Program.
