2019 Town Meeting

This coming Saturday, May 18, the town meeting starts at 10 am. This is an opportunity for residents to come and hear about and vote on the proposed budgets from all departments that receive funds from the town of Edgecomb. As you are all probably aware, we are looking at a 7.92% increase in our PreK - 12 school budget. Mrs. Tanya Thibault and Ms. Jessica Murray have generously agreed to provide free childcare for school-age children (4-12) here at Edgecomb Eddy so that parents might avoid being distracted and better participate in the town meeting. Children coming for childcare need to bring their own bag lunch. 6th grade students will be preparing and selling lunch at the town meeting as a fundraiser for their Boston trip. They will also be selling raffle tickets for a free overnight stay at the Cod Cove Inn (Edgecomb) or the Cedar Crest Inn (Camden) valued at nearly \$200. Raffle tickets are \$5 a piece or 6 for \$25.
