ALL new and returning students planning on attending Emerado Public School in the 2019/2020 school year need to come to registration. Anyone coming to register a student need to have the following forms with you at the time of registration:

- * Birth certificate for ALL students attending Emerado**
- * ALL immunization records**
- * Current address and phone numbers for parents/
guardians**
- * Free & Reduce forms**

Even if your child attended Emerado in the past, you will need to provide a copy of all of these forms as we have had some issues in the past with not being able to obtain these records and it is required by the state that Emerado has these forms for your child to attend school.
