

*The midterm for the 4th nine weeks is April 23. It's hard to believe this year is almost over!

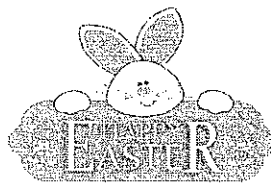
*The last MAP Testing for the year will take place next week. Our students have shown good growth this year so we're excited to see how they finish up on the end of the year assessment.

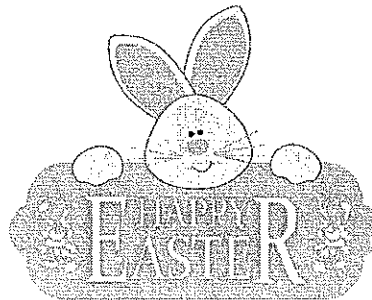
South Elementary School Board Report April 17, 2019
