#### 8. New Business and Administrative Reports/Updates:

- a. Mrs. Fowler gave an update on current enrollment and where things stand with the budget with increased enrollment. There are currently 84 students enrolled with and the per pupil funding amount is \$9,150. She also provided the staff with an outline of what fund equity has been dating back to the 13-14 school year.
- **b.** Along with a budget update she gave an update on staffing. A fulltime special education teacher has been hired. We have offered someone a fulltime teaching position and we are waiting to hear back from them. We have made no progress in hiring a music teacher. Her recommendation to the Board is hire our former special education teacher as a

- paraprofessional. With the increase in enrollment and per pupil funding there is room in the budget to hire the paraprofessional.
- c. She also gave a few other updates. The open house is scheduled for Monday, August 22 at 6:00pm. The first day of school is Tuesday, August 23. The reading summer boost program is currently happening and there has been a great turnout.
