

Board Responsibilities

The Board of Cooperative Educational Services is responsible for the management of the school system. To ensure the effective daily management of the school system, the Board shall employ a District Superintendent. The Board will develop policies which best serve the educational interests of students and provide the District Superintendent with sufficient and adequate guidelines for implementation. The Board will also be responsible for identifying educational needs and establishing programs and procedures to ensure the educational achievement of students.

The Board is responsible for the financial management of the school system and shall employ an Assistant Superintendent for Business and/or Finance Director to work with the District Superintendent to administer the financial operations of the school system. The Board will develop fiscal policies to ensure the financial integrity of the school system.

The Board shall perform all Board functions and operations in conformity with federal, state, and local laws, rules and regulations.
