

Public Participation at Board Meetings

The Board recognizes the importance of public participation at Board meetings. Each regular meeting shall have a period of time set aside for public comment. To facilitate such participation individuals who wish to address the Board must submit his or her name and the topic upon which he or she wishes to speak at least 48 hours prior to the meeting. Discussion will be limited to three minutes per person during the public comment period, unless extended by the Board President.

The Board reserves the right to develop rules for particular meetings and circumstances.
