

Board Policy Development and Dissemination

The Board recognizes that through policy making the Board exercises its leadership and control over the school system. Board policies will set forth the purposes and prescribe in general terms the organization and program of the BOCES system.

Any staff member, parent, student or community member may submit recommendations concerning the addition, deletion or revision of a Board policy. Recommendations on policies will be given to the Board Policy Committee which will be responsible for reviewing the recommendations and making recommendations to the full Board. The Policy Committee will also be responsible for continually reviewing all Board policies.

The District Superintendent shall be responsible for ensuring Board policies are accessible to all employees of the BOCES system and to Board members. All policy manuals shall remain the property of the Board. The Board's policy manual is a public record and shall be available for inspection by appointment at the Administration Building during regular office hours.
