

### **Formulation, Adoption and Amendment of Policies**

The Board of Education recognizes that the adoption of written policies constitutes the basic method by which the Board exercises its leadership in the operation of the District. The adoption of written policies is the sole prerogative of the Board. To adopt, change, or repeal a policy requires a majority of the full Board.

The Policy Committee will draft a proposed policy or a proposal to repeal a policy after review and discussion by committee members. The draft proposal will be presented at a regular Board meeting for discussion by the entire Board. The Board may vote to adopt, revise or repeal the policy as proposed at this meeting or request further revisions which will then be presented at the next regular meeting.

The policy will continue to be revised by the Policy Committee or designee and resubmitted to the full Board until the Board votes to adopt the new or revised policy or to repeal an existing policy.
