

Administration in Absence of a Board Policy

In the absence of a written Board policy regarding a question that may arise in the operation of the BOCES or other facilities of the Board, the District Superintendent has the power and duty to take action as long as such action does not involve a non-delegable duty of the Board. The action of the District Superintendent should be consistent with overall Board policy and any prior actions of the Board.

The District Superintendent has a responsibility to inform the Board promptly of the action taken and the need for a policy. The Superintendent's decision and action may be subject to review by the Board at its next regular or special meeting.
