



Dress and Grooming Guidelines 2020-2021

Student Grooming

- Hair
 - ❖ Must not be a distraction to the learning environment.

Student Dress

- Shorts, Dresses, and/or Skirts
 - ❖ Must extend and stay to mid-thigh in length
 - ❖ Holes or fraying above mid-thigh are not allowed.
 - ❖ No tube skirts/ dresses allowed.
- Shirts and Tops
 - ❖ Must have sleeves/ No tank tops/ Cut offs
 - ❖ Must cover the torso, no mid-driffs
- Undergarments may not be exposed at any time.
- Jeans and Pants
 - ❖ Holes and fraying above mid-thigh are not allowed.
 - ❖ Excessive holes or excessively large holes are not allowed.
 - ❖ Leggings must be worn with a top that covers the pelvic region and buttocks.
 - ❖ Pajamas/pajama pants are not allowed at any time in school.
- Suggestive/Revealing attire is not acceptable
- Clothing and Jewelry
 - ❖ References to alcohol, drugs, or tobacco are not permitted.
 - ❖ Anything vulgar, sexual, or racial is not permitted.
 - ❖ Flag items on clothing/jewelry which may be interpreted as showing disrespect are not permitted.
- Caps, hats, bandanas, sunglasses, gloves, house slippers, wallet chains, or any clothing containing chains are not permitted.
- Students are not allowed to wear winter coats/outerwear or long overcoats during the school day.

Students who choose to dress inappropriately for school will be instructed to change their clothing before they are admitted to class. Disciplinary consequences may also be issued.
