Applicants must:

- have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher
- · submit a completed application (incomplete applications will not be considered)
- · demonstrate involvement in school and/or community leadership activities

How will applications be evaluated?

- · Strength of letter of recommendation
- · Short answer responses
- Essay
- Resume

Award Details

- \$2,000 one-time scholarship paid directly to the recipient's choice of school (no exceptions)
- 10 recipients will be determined by the Scholarship Committee (all participants must accept their decision as final)
- Proof of enrollment is required before any funds will be dispersed
