

THE LEWIS AND JOHN FRENZL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

PURPOSE: The Lewis & John Frenzl Scholarship Fund is a private, non-profit organization is established exclusively for the purpose of providing academic scholarships to deserving high school seniors attending public high schools in the Washington County area. Student-applicants must show a strong desire to continue their post-secondary educational studies in the fields of agriculture management, animal husbandry, veterinary science, or similar agriculture-related pursuits at the collegiate, trade or technical school level. While a student's agricultural pursuits are a primary consideration for evaluating scholarship candidates, the award is open to any deserving student who may apply.

AMOUNT: Each year five (5) separate scholarships will be awarded to each of the schools in the Washington County area (Akron, Arikaree, Lone Star, Otis, and Woodlin.) The total amount of each scholarship will be \$1,500.00 distributed upon the return of the signed acceptance of terms and conditions page attached to this letter.

CRITERIA:

- Awards will be based on the strength of the student's application, letters of recommendation, and the written essay.
- Qualifying students must be graduating high school seniors with an expressed financial need.
- Awards will be based on the student's commitment to the agriculture field, financial need, academic performance and community service history.
- Applications must be complete and either typed or hand-written in a clear, legible manner.
- Scholarship winners will be notified of their award prior to graduation.
