Dyer County Schools Summer Remediation

The Dyer County School System will offer an elementary and middle school summer remediation program from June 3, 2019, through June 14, 2019. Instruction in grades K-4 will focus on language arts and mathematics. The summer remediation program is available to Dyer County students only. Students in grades K-2 must bring a <u>teacher referral</u> in order to be registered. Students in grades 3-8 must bring a <u>teacher referral and report card</u>. Registration cannot be completed without this information, and a parent/guardian must accompany the student to registration.

The courses available for grades 5-8 will be determined by the needs of the registered students. Students registering for summer remediation may choose the first session which will be from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. or the second session from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. When a session becomes full, students must choose the other session. Summer remediation will be held at Fifth Consolidated Elementary School, 2150 Millsfield Highway. The total cost of the summer program will be \$50.00. **The entire amount is due upon registration**. Registration will be held at Fifth Consolidated Elementary School on the following dates:

Thursday, May 30, 2019 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Friday, May 31, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Summer remediation hours will be from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. for the first session and 11:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. for students in the second session. No breakfast or lunch will be served. Students will be given a snack each day.

Summer remediation will be held at Dyer County High School. The total cost of the summer program is \$50.00 a course. **The entire amount is due upon registration**. Registration will be held at Dyer County High School on the following dates:

Thursday, May 30, 2019 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Friday, May 31, 2019 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
