North Royalton is a suburban, residential community located 15 miles south of downtown Cleveland. The city covers 21.8 square miles and has a population of approximately 32,500. The total North Royalton City School District enrollment is approximately 4,000 students.

North Royalton High School is a 2021 Best High School, based on rankings from U.S. News & World Report. NRHS is ranked 85 (up from 127 last year) within Ohio and 21 in Cleveland (up from 23 last year). Nearly 18,000 schools were nationally ranked and 683 schools were ranked in Ohio.
