The purpose of the strategic plan is to provide direction and focus for leadership in decision-making over the next few years. The strategic plan is a "living document" and is expected to be updated regularly. Each year, the District will align goals and priorities to increase student success.

- Expansion and development of Professional Learning Community (PLC) members' practice by investing time and administrative support.
- Establish baseline data in accordance with state guidelines for student attendance and reduce chronic absence rates to less than 10%.
