The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$17,680.94, Escrow checks totaling \$18,402.81 and Activity checks totaling \$25,323.01, Student Fee checks totaling 495.00 and Cooperative checks totaling 3,474.90.

The Elementary Principal reported the 3rd and 4th grade students attended Life on the Farm. There are currently 18 students that will be entering Kindergarten in the fall. Summer School will be held May 28 through June 28. It will be held at the high school building due to remodeling. The school has hired Mariah Arroyos for the elementary library/para position. Jessica Bertschinger will be teaching Kindergarten beginning in the fall of 2019. The Title 1 Reading/HAL position has been filled by Bridget Sees. She will begin her duties in August. Multicultural night was well attended. The track and field day was held on

May 20th. Events were adjusted due to the weather. Mrs. Gieselman has turned in her resignation as elementary custodian. We are currently taking applications to fill this position.

The Superintendent is waiting until after June 17th to determine 2019-2020 lunch prices. Jessica Bertschinger has been assigned to Kindergarten with Bridget Sees taking the Title 1 Reading/HAL position. There are many end of year reports that will be finalized soon. Drivers Education will begin May 28. Laptops will be imaged or reimaged this summer. There is one student who will be taking credit recovery this summer. Summer projects include Phase 3 remodeling at both the high school and elementary. Asbestos abatement has already started. The weight room is closed until this process is completed at the high school. We are waiting for a quote for the elementary fence. The school has purchased a broom for the skid loader to be used on sidewalks. Mr. Alexander is getting bids for some concrete bids and drop curbs. Some of the cost of this may be split with the city. A bid is being secured for underground sprinklers on the football practice field.

Committee reports included: Americanism/Civics, Administrative Review, Board Policy and Procedures, Negotiations/Staff Relations, Transportation, Building and Grounds and Budget. Due to current legislation the Americanism and Civics committee will need to meet as a committee.

The Board discussed phase 3 remodeling. RaDec and Environmental Services have already started the remodeling. Mr. Alexander mentioned that we usually give \$250 per student that attends a national event. \$750.00 will be deposited into the FCCLA account for these students going to National FCCLA. Some reseeding needs to be done at the football practice field. Kamden Cihlar has finished his graduation requirements and has been awarded a diploma. Diane Gieselman will retire as of June 30th. This position has not yet been filled.

Motion by Mackeprang, seconded by Ziegler, to approve the contract of Bridget Sees as the new Title 1 Reading/High Ability teacher for the 2019-2020 school year.
