Announcements are broadcast between 5:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. School closings or delayed openings are announced. If a closing is not announced, school is in session. You are asked not to call the school during such emergencies, as the school lines are busy with outgoing notification calls.

Parents/guardians should establish procedures with their children that can be implemented whenever a daytime emergency school closing (caused by weather conditions, etc.) or transportation problem (buses not running) occurs at school. Parents/guardians should inform the school about the procedures established with the children.

Apptegy, the district's notification system, will contact employees and parents/guardians of students regarding school closings due to inclement weather. TRANSPORTATION ELIGIBILITY

Transportation is provided for those children in kindergarten through grade five who live more than 1.23 miles and up to 15 miles, grades six through eight who live more than 2 miles and grades 9-12 who live more than 2 miles from the school they attend. Eligible pupils will receive identification cards in the mail.

The application deadline for private and parochial school transportation is April 1, 2024. All applications must be postmarked by April 1, 2024.

FEDERAL EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT

Unless objection to any of the specific items of information following is submitted in writing by parents or legal guardians, or by those students themselves who are 18 years of age and older, the Bayport-Blue Point School District herewith gives notice of intention to provide, release or publish in the Bayport-Blue Point newsletter, school or student newspapers, magazines, yearbooks or other publications, daily or weekly newspapers, athletic programs, musical or theatrical programs, news releases and video any and/or all of the following information pertaining to students as may be appropriate under the circumstances: name of student, names of parents/guardians, address, age, grade, participation in recognized school activities, extracurricular activities and sports programs, academic honors, achievements, awards, scholarships and similar information. Under the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act, parents/guardians who do not desire the release of any of the above directory information must make a specific request in writing to the Superintendent of Schools by September 29, 2023. Failure to make such a request shall be deemed as consent to release, provide or publish the directory information during the school year.

CLEAN AIR IN DISTRICT FACILITIES

The Bayport-Blue Point School District recognizes the importance of clean air in the workplace to employee health and productivity. It is therefore the intention of BOE policy #1530 to assure a healthy work environment for all district employees and a healthy environment in which children can learn.

The district shall comply fully with the New York State Clean Indoor Air Act, Suffolk County Local Law No. 421 and Goals 2000 Educate America Act. Specifically, smoking shall be prohibited in all district buildings, including classrooms, elevators, restrooms, medical facilities, conference rooms, meeting rooms, faculty rooms, administrative offices, faculty offices, lobbies, hallways and locker rooms. No one shall be permitted to smoke in or on school district facilities and grounds at any time.

SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973

This announcement is published in compliance with the regulations of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 as amended in 1974. COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL STATUTES

Freedom of Information Law – The Bayport-Blue Point Union Free School District adopted on October 22, 1974, guidelines for implementation of Public Officers Law Article 6 providing for the inspection and copying of public records. These guidelines designate district officers, locations for submission of requests, times when records are available, and procedures, including procedures for appeal and fees. In general, the principal of each school is the officer for his/her school, and the Records Retention and Disposition Officer for the finance and district offices. Records are available between 8:15 a.m. and 3 p.m. during regular school hours.

Parents' Right-to-Know – As per the No Child Left Behind 2001 Parents' Right-to-Know requirements, parents/guardians have the right to know the qualifications of their child's classroom teacher(s) and paraprofessional staff. If you wish to receive this information, please address the request, in writing, to the Office of Human Resources.

Title IX Sex Discrimination – The Bayport-Blue Point School District does not discriminate on the basis of sex in the educational programs or activities which it operates, and it is required by Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972 not to discriminate in such a manner. This policy of nondiscrimination includes the benefits and counseling services for students, access by students to educational programs, course offerings and student activities. The designated Title IX district official will be responsible for the coordination of activities relating to compliance with Title IX. This official will provide information, including complaint procedures, to any student or employee who feels that his/her rights under Title IX may have been violated by the district or its officials. CENSUS

To plan for the District's educational needs, we continually update our census data to identify all children, ages birth to 18, who reside in the District. This information is vital to projecting future programs and determining building needs.

PARENTS FOR MEGAN'S LAW

To provide parents/guardians and residents with information concerning convicted sex offenders who are living or working in this district, our school district is now benefiting from a no-cost sex offender email alert notification program. SCHOOL PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION

To Students, Parents and School Personnel:

New York State Education Law, Section 409H, effective July 1, 2001, requires that all public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools provide written notification to all persons in a parental relationship, faculty and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.

The Bayport-Blue Point School District is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation, faculty and staff who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are <u>not</u> subject to prior notification requirements:

- A school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following an application.
- Antimicrobial products.
- Nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper-resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children.
- Nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper-resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children.
- Silica gel and other nonvolatile ready-to-use pastes, foams or gels in areas inaccessible to children.
- Boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate.
- The application of EPA-designated biopesticides.
- The application of EPA-designated exempt materials under 40CFR152.25.
- The use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging

and biting insects, including venomous spiders, bees, wasps and hornets.

In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a good faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48-hour prior notification list. If you would like to receive 48-hour prior notification of pesticide applications that are scheduled to occur in your school, please contact the Bayport-Blue Point School District, 189 Academy Street, Bayport, NY 11705, or call Bryan Bortzfield, Director of Facilities III, at 631-472-7816, each fiscal year if you wish to maintain your status on our contact list.

ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION

The District's ongoing asbestos program complies with the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). The District is performing its periodic inspections this year of all the buildings and will continue its semiannual surveillance requirements under the regulations of AHERA. Results are included in each building's management plan.

Any individual may review a building's management plan by going to the school's main office. Copies of all the schools' management plans are also available for review at the District Office, 189 Academy Street, Bayport, NY 11705, in the Buildings and Grounds Department.

POLICY

SEXUAL HARASSMENT

The district is committed to providing an educational and working environment that promotes respect, dignity and equality and that is free from all forms of sexual harassment. To this end, the Board of Education condemns and strictly prohibits all forms of sexual harassment on school grounds, school buses and at all schoolsponsored activities, programs and events including those that take place at locations outside the School District. Such harassment may be reported in person, by mail, by telephone, or by electronic mail using the contact information listed for the Title IX Coordinator and/or Compliance Officer, or by any other means that results in the Title IX Coordinator and/or Compliance Officer receiving the person's verbal or written report. Such report may be made at any time (including during non-business hours) by using the telephone number or electronic mail address, or by mail to the office address, listed for the Title IX Coordinator or Compliance Officer. The School District will promptly investigate all complaints of sexual harassment, either formal or informal, verbal or written. To the extent possible, all complaints will be treated in a confidential manner. The Board of Education has adopted a policy, Policy 0110, Sexual Harassment, in regard to this process. This policy is in accordance with legal reference: Education Amendments of 1972, Title IX, 20 U.S.C.§1681 et seg. Title VII of Civil Rights Act (1964), 42 U.S.C. §2000-e; 34 CFR §100 et seq.
