SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM

Barneveld School District students shall have an opportunity to participate in the National School Lunch Program. Food service prices may be established by the Barneveld School Board and approved at the Annual Meeting.

The District will offer a school lunch meeting federal regulations to all students. Free and reduced priced lunches will be offered to eligible students who apply and who meet the federal income guideline.

1. Weekly notices are sent by email to parents.
2. Every two weeks a report of negative balances is given to the District Administrator.
3. If any account is a negative \$25 or more, a letter is sent by mail to the parents informing them that if payment is not received in full or a payment plan is not made, their child(ren) will be given a sandwich and milk (charged to the students account).

The Barneveld School District does have recourse to collect delinquent debt (charges) in small claims court. The Barneveld School District may take legal action against a household which has not settled its food service debt.
